(Ephesians 4:17-32; Isaiah 61:10" Acts 26:18)

- 1. The Christian should put away lying (vs. 25). The verse is self-explanatory (Romans 12:5; Zechariah 8:16). We are members of the same body. This word *neighbour* refers to another Christian in Christ. It is extremely difficult to be honest at ALL TIMES. The Christian who will not admit this is somewhat of a liar himself.
- 2. The Christian should speak... the truth (vs. 25).
- 3. Be ye angry, and sin not... (vs. 26). The Christian can get angry at times (Titus 1:13; II Corinthians 13:2), but he is not to "serve sin" when he gets angry as it gives place to the devil. Jesus was angry at nothing but sin and was angry at no one but the religious leaders of the Ecumenical council of His day.
- 4. ...let not the sun go down upon your wrath (vs. 26). Twelve hours is long enough to be mad at anybody. If you go on with it, you will lose sleep. You may get ulcers from a grudge if you keep nursing it (Leviticus 19:18); and if you die in your sleep, you will have to deal with it again at the Judgment Seat of Christ (I Tim 5:25).
- **5. Neither give place to the devil (vs. 27)**. You will do this if you keep on nursing grudges (cf. II Corinthians 2:10-11).
- 6. Let him that stole steal no more... (vs. 28).
- 7. Let him labour, working with his hands ... that he may have to give... (vs. 28). The Bible encourages men to work (II Thessalonians 3:10). The real Christian goes beyond the requirements of providing for his own house; he works so that he may have to give to him that needeth (vs. 28).
- **8.9.** The eighth admonition is against **corrupt communica**tion (vs. 29), and the positive half of the verse (the ninth admonition) encourages that which is good ... that it may minister grace unto the hearers. Corrupt communication includes the passing on of rumors, the inventing of slander, the dirty joke, the "off color joke" (see 5:3-4), and any language that is foul, filthy, rude, or obscene. "Good words and fair speeches" do not remedy the problem because "good words and fair speeches" (Romans 16:18) are quite characteristic of the most corrupt communicators.

Also see Acts 24:16; II Timothy 2:23-26 about being offensive and striving with those caught up Satan's snares.

The AV 1611 has never been guilty of a corrupt communication or of a corrupt text; however, he scholars who have lied to their followers and 'customers' are professional liars & corrupters!

10. The tenth warning is "grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption" (vs. 30; cf. 1:13-14). Since the Holy Spirit is a Person (John 16:13), He can be grieved, He can be resisted (Acts 7:51), and He can be lied to (Acts **5:3**). The Christian is sealed unto the Day of Redemption exactly as the unsaved sinner is sealed unto the Day of Perdition (**Eph 1:13**).

The Holy Spirit is grieved with foolish talking and jesting, sin and uncleanness, all unrighteousness, lying, loafing, exaggerating, selfpity, lack of concern, lack of gratitude, lack of fruit (see Galatians 5:22), grumbling, murmuring, stinginess, jealousy, false accusations, lack of faith, refusal to testify, indifference to the Bible, perversion of the truth, failure to praise God, and worrying.

"The day of redemption" is the "day of Christ" (see II Corinthians 1:22; I Corinthians 1:8; 4:5; II Timothy 4:8; II Thessalonians 2:2).

Now, follow six more admonitions; the Christian is to get rid of

11. Bitterness; 12. Wrath; 13. Anger; 14. Clamour 15. Evil speaking: 16. All malice

Anger is cruel, wrath is outrageous (Proverbs 27:4), bitterness is sin (Hebrews 12:15), clamour is one of the works of the flesh (Ephesians 4:31), evil speaking is a violation of Ephesians 4:29, and malice is part of the old life (Titus 3:3). Malice is an attitude; clamour is the result of anger and wrath. Evil speaking can cause bitterness. Bitterness is a stimulant to wrath and anger. (More light on these terms is found in Acts 8:23; Rom 3:14; 12:5; I Tim 6:4; Col. 3:8).

17. Be ve kind; 18. Tenderhearted; 19. Forgiving one another

What should be the easiest thing to do is often the hardest. Personal hurts and personal injuries are to be overlooked, forgotten, put away, or ignored altogether (Colossians 3:13).

The tendency to retaliate where one has been slandered or reviled is part of the old humus of human nature. The passage is not referring to being **kind** towards critics who hate and attack God's word (note Titus 1:10-12; I Timothy 1:20), but it is a personal reference to personal dealings. II Timothy 2:24-26

Christians are very unkind to one another; they are not in the least tenderhearted in the middle of church splits, doctrinal controversies, and business meetings. The ones who talk the most about courtesy, love, politeness, and soft words are usually the most vicious and venomous in an out-and-out showdown.

Forgiving one another should come easy in view of the fact that ... God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you (vs. 32).

But many Christians were saved in their early years and it is very hard to convince them that God had to forgive them of anything really BAD. These "Christian nurtured," "Christian raised,"

"Christian trained" "Believers" are often the most vicious foes of Biblical preaching that one can imagine. They hold grudges for decades and even pass them on to their children. (Luke 7:47).
