Distributing to the necessity of saints;
given to hospitality.*

*Rejoice with them that do rejoice,
and weep with them that weep.

*Mind not high things,
but condescend to men of low estate.
Be not wise in your own conceits.*

TRIBULATION APPLICATION

These verses have application during the Tribulation only—not loving the brethren will result in the loss of one's salvation!

That is how important the brethren to each other. We can learn from that for today's importance, eh?

Hebrews 3:12,13

*Take heed, brethren, lest there be in any of you an evil
heart of unbelief, in departing from the living God.
But exhort one another daily, while it is called To day;
lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness
of sin.*

Hebrews 10:24,25

*And let us consider one another to provoke unto love
and to good works: Not forsaking the assembling of
ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but ex-
horting one another: and so much the more, as ye see
the day approaching.*

James 5:16

*Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for
another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent
prayer of a righteous man availeth much.*

I Peter 1:22

*Seeing ye have purified your souls in obeying the truth
through the Spirit unto unfeigned love of the brethren,
see that ye love one another with a pure heart fer-
vently:*

I Peter 4:7-10

*But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore so-
ber, and watch unto prayer. And above all things have
fervent charity among yourselves: for charity shall
cover the multitude of sins. Use hospitality one to an-
other without grudging. As every man hath received
the gift, even so minister the same one to another, as
good stewards of the manifold grace of God.*

*Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the

II Corinthians 5:1-10

For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, an house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven: If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked.

For we that are in this tabernacle do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life.

Now he that hath wrought us for the selfsame thing is God, who also hath given unto us the earnest of the Spirit.

Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord: (For we walk by faith, not by sight:) We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord.

Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.

Remember - WE are God's building! Take good care of it!

How to Have Peace with the Worldly Brethren

Now we command you, brethren, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that ye withdraw yourselves from every brother that walketh disorderly, and not after the tradition which he received of us. For yourselves know how ye ought to follow us: for we behaved not ourselves disorderly among you;

And if any man obey not our word by this epistle, note that man, and have no company with him, that he may be ashamed. Yet count him not as an enemy, but admonish him as a brother. Now the Lord of peace himself give you peace always by all means. The Lord be with you all.

The Importance of His Builders

I Corinthians 3:9-11

For we are labourers together with God: ye are God's husbandry, ye are God's building.

According to the grace of God which is given unto me, as a wise masterbuilder, I have laid the foundation, and another buildeth thereon.

But let every man take heed how he buildeth thereupon.

For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ.

Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble; Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is. If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward. If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.
