Death is not to be Feared - if you are SAVED!

Psalm 116:15

Precious in the sight of the LORD is the death of his saints.

Ecclesiastes 7:1

A good name is better than precious ointment;
and the day of death than the day of one's birth.

I Thessalonians 4:13,14

But I would not have you to be ignorant, brethren, concerning them which are asleep, that ye sorrow not, even as others which have no hope. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

II Corinthians 5:6-10

6: Therefore we are always confident, knowing that, whilst we are at home in the body, we are absent from the Lord: 7: (For we walk by faith, not by sight:) 8: We are confident, I say, and willing rather to be absent from the body, and to be present with the Lord. 9: Wherefore we labour, that, whether present or absent, we may be accepted of him. 10: For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.

How Do You "Receive Christ" for your Salvation?

Remember what God has done in your life!

Psalm 143:5 I remember the days of old; I meditate on all thy works; I muse on the work of thy hands.

Psalm 77:11 I will remember the works of the LORD: surely I will remember thy wonders of old.

Psalm 37:25 I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread.

Psalm 44:1 We have heard with our ears, O God, our fathers have told us, what work thou didst in their days, in the times of old.

Psalm 77:1-14 (A great series of verses to read!)

Psalm 119:52 I remembered thy judgments of old, O LORD; and have comforted myself.

Jeremiah 6:16 Thus saith the LORD, Stand ye in the ways, and see, and ask for the old paths, where is the good way, and walk therein, and ye shall find rest for your souls. But they said, We will not walk therein.

You still have a Purpose in this life!

Psalm 92:14 They shall still bring forth fruit in old age; they shall be fat and flourishing;

Psalm 71:18 Now also when I am old and grayheaded, O God, forsake me not; until I have shewed thy strength unto this generation, and thy power to every one that is to come.

Proverbs 23:10 Remove not the old landmark; and enter not into the fields of the fatherless:

Psalm 78:4 We will not hide them from their children, shewing to the generation to come the praises of the LORD, and his strength, and his wonderful works that he hath done.

Psalm 48:13,14 Mark ye well her bulwarks, consider her palaces; that ye may tell it to the generation following. For this God is our God for ever and ever: he will be our guide even unto death.

The Glory and Beauty of Old Men

Proverbs 17:6 Children's children are the crown of old men; and the glory of children are their fathers.

Proverbs 20:29 The glory of young men is their strength: and the beauty of old men is the gray head.

Psalm 71:9

Cast me not off in the time of old age;
forsake me not when my strength faileth.

Your wisdom and understanding 'peaks'!

Job 12:12 With the ancient is wisdom;
and in length of days understanding.

Even as we age, are we still willing to learn from the Bible and make some changes in our life?

Ecclesiastes 4:13 Better is a poor and a wise child than an old and foolish king, who will no more be admonished.

God's own wonderful words describe aging!

Ecclesiastes 12:1-7

Remember now thy Creator in the days of thy youth,
while the evil days come not, nor the years draw nigh,
when thou shalt say, I have no pleasure in them;
While the sun, or the light, or the moon, or the stars,
be not darkened, nor the clouds return after the rain:
In the day when the keepers of the house shall tremble,
and the strong men shall bow themselves,
and the grinders cease because they are few,
and those that look out of the windows be darkened,
And the doors shall be shut in the streets,
when the sound of the grinding is low,
and he shall rise up at the voice of the bird,
and all the daughters of musick shall be brought low;
Also when they shall be afraid of that which is high,
and fears shall be in the way,
and the almond tree shall flourish,
and the grasshopper shall be a burden, and desire shall fail:
because man goeth to his long home,
and the mourners go about the streets:
Or ever the silver cord be loosed,
or the golden bowl be broken,
or the pitcher be broken at the fountain,
or the wheel broken at the cistern.
Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was:
and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it.
