

**God is Great, God is Good,
but let us thank Him for more than just food!**

Here are a few Scriptural facts about the goodness of God today that are found only in Paul's writings and only from within a King James Bible.

Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?
Romans 2:4

It is because of God's goodness that judgment is being held out from God today for the lost or the saved. We can not decide if anything is pleasing to God by trying to observe judgment and/or personal or national physical chastisement.

Because of God's goodness, forbearing and longsuffering, the Scriptures tell us there is no judgment or chastisement from God towards us today!

However, the chastenings and judgments are coming!

We still can reap what we sow, but it isn't God's judgment or chastisement!

Today is the dispensation of grace! To learn about God's goodness, one must look to a King James Bible and then look specifically to Paul's Epistles for the teachings of the Risen Saviour to us today.

For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles, If ye have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which is given me to you-ward:

How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words, Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ)
Ephesians 3:1-4

Open a King James Bible and look up these verses. Note: this is only a small list of verses that tells us about the goodness of God today. The goodness of God is not reserved for the 'saved' only - but the goodness of God towards a lost person is still different.

- * We are a new creature - We are now His workmanship—**Gal 6:15; II Cor 5:17**
- * No forced bondage—only by choice - **Gal 5:1**
- * No confusion - no contradictions - **I Cor 14:33**
- * Rapture to look forward to - **I Cor 15:51-52**
- * Judgment Seat judging works, not sins instead of the white throne judgment - **II Cor 5:10**
- * Children of God by faith, not by being a peacemaker or by good works - **Gal 3:26**
- * Rapture determined by - **Romans 11:22**

The Great White Throne Judgment

Revelation 20:11-15

And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works. - * Redeemed to receive the adoption of sons - **Galatians 4:3-7**
- * Gospel personally taught to Paul by Jesus Christ and then to us today - **Gal 1:11,12**
- * Allows us the opportunity to 'not' be ignorant of Satan's devices - **II Corinthians 2:11**
- * We are now his workmanship, created unto good works... **Ephesians 2:10**
- * Made nigh unto God by the blood of the Risen Saviour - **Ephesians 2:13**
- * We are an habitation of God - **Ephesians 2:22**
- * We can see the fellowship of the mystery. **Eph 3:9** with enlightened eyes **Acts 26:18**
- * We have boldness and access with confidence. **Ephesians 3:12**
- * We were chosen to be holy and without blame before him in love - not predestined souls - but we will be without blame after our Judgment Seat - **Eph 1:4,5; 7-12**
- * Christ dwells in our hearts by faith - **Eph 3:17**
- * We have the faith OF Christ when we put our faith IN Christ! **Galatians 2:16**
- * We live by His faith, not our faith! **Gal 2:20**
- * There is no more law to a Believer! **Galatians 3:13; Romans 10:4; I Cor 6:12**
- * We have redemption, the forgiveness of sins, thus nothing to 'confess.' **Eph 1:7** and not **I John 1:9** - that is not 'to' us today.
- * A pastor is not to be our final authority at all. See **Eph 4:11** and note **Heb 13:7,17** - are not to us but to those during the Trib.
