

Roman 6 - 'Living in Sin' or 'Living in Christ?'

There's no such thing as "living in sin" for a Christian; We are living in Christ. "**God forbid, How shall we that are dead to sin...**" And we are - we're dead! Now, how do we know we're dead? **Verse 7: "He that is dead..."** **Verse 8: "Now if we be dead..."** **Verse 11: "Reckon ye also yourselves to be dead..."** There's no way we can "live in sin." As Christians, we live in Christ. We may do "wrong," but we can not *live in sin*, because a dead man can't *live in sin* - we are dead! The wrong we do will be judged in the Judgment Seat of Christ.

Here is how this works: As far as the practical outworking of that life goes, this flesh right here - that thing is crucified with Christ. So, right now, our physical body is suffering a slow, lingering death.

In God's sight, we are already dead and buried! God doesn't recognize this flesh. God doesn't pay any attention. As far as God is concerned, we trusted Christ, our flesh is dead and buried and rotting, and that's the end of it.

The time that we spend now working for this flesh is wasted time - because the Lord doesn't put any of it down. Whatever is done in this flesh is not imputed because our flesh is dead! **Romans 4:8 Blessed is the man to whom the Lord will not impute sin.**

Inside us, the new man is up walking around. "**Nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me. And the life I now live in the flesh...**" So you have those three things. When you trust Jesus Christ as your Saviour, you go into His life, and His life goes into us. Now, that's a tremendous transaction, folks.

There is an expression that people use today that is satanic. It is, "*Christ coming into my life.*"

If Christ isn't in your body, you're going to hell. You must understand that. "*Christ in your life*" amounts to nothing at all. If that were true, then He might go in and out of your life every other week. It's *Christ in you*, the hope of glory. When they substitute that word "life" for "body" they put you off track.

If we '*give Christ our life*,' we'll still go to hell. He's got to be in our body!

Remember, All Things are Still Not Expedient!

Paul Fought the Same Battles We Do

For I know that in me (that is, in my flesh,) dwelleth no good thing: for to will is present with me; but how to perform that which is good I find not. For the good that I would I do not: but the evil which I would not, that I do. Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me. I find then a law, that, when I would do good, evil is present with me. For I delight in the law of God after the inward man: But I see another law in my members, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to the law of sin which is in my members. Romans 7:18-23
